Tools Required

- $10 \mathrm{~mm}, 15 \mathrm{~mm}, 7 / 16$ ", $9 / 16$ " socket
- $7 / 16$ ", $9 / 16$ " wrench

1. Using a 15 mm socket, remove the $2 x$ bolts on the A-Pillar. With the supplied hardware, mount the new bracket on the outside of the cage as shown.
Tip: if the cage separates, use a punch to re-align the cage.
2. Using a $9 / 16$ " wrench and socket, place the light mount on the bracket.

3. Using a $7 / 16$ " wrench. Attach the light to the bracket. Angle to achieve the desired lighting. Route the harness under the hood and out where the a-pillar goes through the hood. Plug the light into the harness.
4. Repeat steps $1-3$ for the opposite side. Route the wires to the terminal block.

5. Using a 10 mm socket, place the red ring terminal on the accessory post. Place the black terminal on the ground post. Route the switch through the firewall just below the terminal block.
6. Use one of the existing switch locations on the dash to place the new switch.


Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.
Re-torque all the fasteners after $\mathbf{1 0 0}$ miles.
