At our option, we will repair or replace items in question and return them at no charge. If the identical product is no longer available, we will replace with a similar product of equal value. Baja Designs Inc. will not be responsible for any indirect or consequential damages in connection with defective merchandise. Items purchased through a Baja Designs authorized dealer must be returned through the dealer. Only available on LED auxiliary lights and product must be in sellable condition at MSRP. Product that has been damaged in any way after the original purchase date will be excluded from this guarantee.


Indemnification:



Tools Required

- * 4mm, 5mm Hex Key
- * 10mm, 13mm, 7/16", 9/16" socket
- * 7/16", 9/16" wrench
- 1. Open the hood. Using a 13mm Socket, loosen the rear hood hinge bolt. The bolt does not need to be completely removed as the bracket is slotted for ease in assembly.
- 2. On the passenger side, remove the radio antenna by rotating




- plastic cowling tabs. Once unclipped, pull up on the plastic cowling releasing the plastic push clips.
- 4. Using a 10mm socket, remove the top fender bolt.




6. After the brackets are installed, route the wiring to each of the two lights.

















- 7. Using a 12mm socket, remove the battery strap. Using a 10mm socket, remove the battery terminals starting with the ground (black) terminal.
- 8. Once the battery is removed, locate the auxiliary wires underneath the engine bay sheet metal on the passenger side. Take the supplied wiring harness and place the 3/8" ring terminal on the black wire onto the chassis ground directly above the auxiliary wires.
- 9. **Squadron Kit Only:** Sperate the auxiliary wires. Use either auxiliary wire 2 (Green/Brown) or 3 (Green/Blue) for the main power (White Wire). Take the clasp connector on the up-fitter harness and close over the desired wire using pliers.
- 10. **XL / LP Kit Only:** Remove the toggle switch from both harnesses. Attach the trigger switch harness to the relay harness. Use the dummy plug to seal the open connector.
- 11. XL / LP Kit: Use any auxiliary wire for the main power. Place the splice connector on the wiring harness over the desired wire, use a pair of pliers to force shut over the wire. If you have the LP kit and desire the backlighting feature, plug in the male connector on the supplied backlight harness into position 3 on the main harness. Route the clasp connector to any of the auxiliary wires and force shut over it.
- 12. Once the lights are wired correctly, finish re-installing all the components taken apart. If you have the squadron kit, the job is done. If you have the XL or LP Kit, use the body fastener in front of the battery to mount the relay. Using a 10mm socket, remove the fastener, install the relay and torque down.
- *Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.
- * Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
