




Tools Required


- * T-10 Torx Bit
- *Pliers
- * 7mm, 7/16" Socket
- * 7/16" Wrench
- 1. Using a T-10 torx bit, remove the 4x bolts securing the splash guard. Pull the splash guard to the side exposing the flog light.







- 2. Using a 7mm socket, remove the 3x fasteners securing the fog light. Unplug the fog lights connector.
- 3. At the top of the fog light mount is a small plastic guide tab. Using any type of snips, trim the tab off so the surface is flush with the U-nut.






- 4. Install the S1's into the bracket as shown.
- 5. Place the bracket onto the OEM mount. Place the supplied spacer in between the bumper and bracket on the mount shown. On the same mount, use the supplied screw instead of the OEM fastener.







- 6. Plug in the supplied $1 \rightarrow 2$ splitter harness into the top fog light. Plug in the supplied $2 \rightarrow 1$ Anti-Back feed Splitter into the bottom fog light. Plug in both splitter harnesses together. Plug in the OEM fog light connector into the $2 \rightarrow 1$ Anti-Back feed Splitter.
- 7. Attach the red terminal on the main harness to the battery positive. Attach the black terminal to the nearest chassis ground. Route the main harness from the battery down to each side of the vehicle. Connect the main harness to the $1 \rightarrow 2$ Splitter harness.






- 8. Take the supplied trigger harness and remove the toggle switch. Replace the toggle switch with the jumper plug. Remove the toggle switch from the main harness. Attach the trigger harness to the main harness.
- 9. Locate the head light connector on the back side of the passenger side headlight. Un-plug the connector.





10. Locate the high beam wire. It will be the wire connected to the top left port when the release tab is located on the top. Take the clasp connector on the trigger harness and place it over the wire. Using pliers, force the splice connector shut.



- *Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.
 - * Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
