At our option, we will repair or replace items in question and return them at no charge. If the identical product is no longer available, we will replace with a similar product of equal value. Baja Designs Inc. will not be responsible for any indirect or consequential damages in connection with defective merchandise.

Items purchased through a Baja Designs authorized dealer must be returned through the dealer. Only available on LED auxiliary lights and product must be in sellable condition at MSRP. Product that has been damaged in any way after the original purchase date will be excluded from this guarantee.

Bronco Raptor Instructions

Tools Required

Bronco Raptor

- *4mm Hex Key
- * 15mm, T-10 Torx socket
- * Trim removal tool, hooked pick, or flathead screwdriver

1. With a 15mm socket, remove the front two bolts (circled) securing the front skid plate. Loosen the rear two skid plate bolts (arrowed) until the skid plate can be removed.

2. With a trim removal tool or flathead screwdriver, remove the 4 plastic push rivets (circled) that secure the passenger side fog light splash guard. Unplug the two fog lights from the OEM wiring by pulling back on the red tab and pushing down on the black release tab.


3.Using a T-10 Torx bit, remove the 6x bolts (per light, arrowed) securing the fog light.


4. Attach the supplied brackets to the light. Each light will have two brackets. The longer bracket will be bolted to the outside. A passenger side light is shown for example. Make sure to use the supplied serrated washers in between the bracket and light to eliminate any rotation from vibration.

5. Before tightening down the light, angle the bracket roughly 2° to the face of the light. Lightly tighten the bracket & place the light into the OEM fog light bracket. Check to ensure the light is centered. Once all are verified, finish torquing down the bracket onto the lights.

6. Place both the lights into the OEM fog light bracket. It is recommended that the wide cornering lens be used in the outermost position. Use 4x of the T-10 Torx screws removed in step 3 to secure each light.














Note: This kit will not work on all Bronco models, only the Bronco Raptor


7. Using the supplied wire harness adapter, connect the adapter to the light and OEM wiring. The same functions will power the lights...

OEM Fog Light Switch \rightarrow Outer Lights Aux Switch $1 \rightarrow$ Center Lights

<u>SAE Only Kit</u>: Beginning with the driver side connect the lights together with the provided splitter harness. Now connect the splitter to the adapter harness and plug into the OEM wiring. Repeat with the passenger side.

8. Reinstall the fog light splash guard and secure using the 4 removed plastic push rivets. Repeat steps 2 through 8 for the driver side of the vehicle.

9. Slide the skid plate back into position and secure using the four bolts from step 1 using a 15mm socket.

F-150 Raptor Instructions

Tools Required

- * 4mm, 5mm Hex Key
- * 8mm, 10mm, 7/16", 9/16", T-10 Torx, T-40 Torx socket
- * 7/16", 9/16" wrench

1. Using a 10mm socket, remove the 4x bolts securing the fog light splash guard (术). Use a 8mm socket to remove the 1x fastener securing the bumper support (木). Loosen the bumper support bolt on the other side and place the support to the side.


2. Using a T-40 Torx bit, remove the 2x bolts securing the top of the fog light bracket. Unplug the 2 lights from the OEM wiring by pulling back on the red tab and pushing down on the release tab.


3.Using a T-10 Torx bit, remove the 6x bolts (per light, arrowed) securing the light.

4. Attach the supplied brackets to the light. Each light will have two brackets. The longer bracket will be bolted to the outside. A passenger side light is shown for example. Make sure to use the supplied serrated washes in between the bracket and light to eliminate any rotation from vibration.

5. Before torquing down the light, angle the bracket roughly 2° to the face of the light. Lightly tighten the bracket & place the light into the OEM fog light bracket. Check to ensure the light is centered. Once all are verified, finish torquing down the bracket onto the lights.

6. Place all the lights into the OEM fog light bracket. Use 4x T-10 Torx screws removed in step 3 to secure each light.



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8. Using a T-40 Torx bit, replace the 2 bolts securing the top of the fog light bracket.

9. Using an 8mm socket, replace the bumper support fastener. With the 10mm socket, reinstall the 4 bolts securing the fog light splash guards removed in step 1. Repeat steps 1 through 9 for the opposite side of the vehicle.

*Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.

* Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
