We will, however, pass on all warranties made by the manufacturer, who has sole responsibility for performing such warranties.

Baja Designs will pay the freight if your product is less than 90 days old, otherwise defective products must be returned to Baja Designs, Inc., freight prepaid. At our option, we will repair or replace items in question and return them at no charge. If the identical product is no longer available, we will replace with a similar product of equal value. Items purchased through a Baja Designs authorized dealer must be returned through the dealer. Only available on LED auxiliary lights and product must be in sellable condition at MSRP. Product that has been damaged in any way after the original purchase date will be excluded from this guarantee.




S1 Moto Kit Instructions

Tools Required

- 7/16" wrench and socket
- 8mm Socket Wrench w/ extension
- 1. To begin, determine where the lights can be mounted to the forks without interference from the gas tank, radiator, or shrouds. Turn the bars back and forth to see the clearance that is available along the forks. **Do not mount where the lower fork guards will interfere when compressed.**
- 2. Remove the headlight. Unplug necessary headlight features such as, turn signals, ignition switch, etc.
- 3. Assemble the brackets as shown.
- 4. The S1 light and bracket assembly exploded view is on the right. Use the 7/16" wrench and socket two attach the S1 bracket to the bracket assembly from step 3. Hold off on mounting the light for now.
- 5. Depending on how the lights are mounted, the bezels may need to be rotated for proper lens alignment. Use the T10 Torx bit to remove the four bezel bolts. Take care not to let the reflector fall out of the light. The bezel needs to be mounted with the branding right side up. Spin the bezel and lens together, make sure o-ring is clean and seated, and screw the bolts in and tighten (5 in*lbs).
- 6. There are multiple ways to configure the brackets. The bracket can extend out to the front of the vehicle or extend out to the side.
- 7. Once the mounting locations and configuration is chosen, carefully wrap the hose-clamp around the forks and through the slot in the brackets. Rotate the clamp to the desired location. Tighten with the 8mm socket wrench. Repeat for the other side.
- 8. Route the S1 power chords to the front of the steering tube area. Attach supplied splitter harness to the lights.
- 9. Run the splitter through the triple clamps along the frame. Make sure the wires will allow the bike to steer with no potential interference.

- Phillip's head screwdriver
- T10 Torx Bit
















- 10. Unravel the provided S1 Moto Kit wiring harness and locate the light plug lead. Attach the plug to the splitter harness from step 8.
- 11. Determine an appropriate mounting location on the handlebar for the switch. Unplug the switch lead from the harness, route the switch wires around handlebar and clamps, and reconnect the switch plug. Use the Phillip's head screwdriver to remove the switch clamp, place the clamp over the handlebar, and tighten the screws into the switch.
- 12. Route the battery leads safely under the gas tank and under the seat to the battery location. Applications will vary for this step. Refer to factory service manuals for specific disassembly guidance.
- 13. With the 8mm socket wrench (Applications vary), remove the black (-) battery terminal bolt and remove the negative lead. Remove the red (+) battery terminal bolt and place the S1 Moto wiring harness red (+) ring terminal over and tighten the fastener. Place the negative battery lead back onto the battery. Attach the S1 Moto wiring harness black (-) ring terminal over the negative lead and tighten the fastener.
- 14. Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components. Replace seat, tank, and any other parts removed to route the harness.







Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
