At our option, we will repair or replace items in question and return them at no charge. If the identical product is no longer available, we will replace it with a similar product of equal value. To begin, make sure the vehicle is in park, on level ground and the parking brake is engaged.

Step 1: Remove the factory light trim ring, followed by the factory light and bracket. Save the screws that attached the "Outer" light ring to your fairing.

Step 2: Unplug your factory light and set it aside on a microfiber towel or surface that will prevent scratches.

Step 3: Using the 1/4x20 bolts supplied in the included hardware bag, attach the DOT LP6 light to the new bracket, leave the front adjustment bolts slightly loose for future angle adjustment.

Step 4: Connect the DOT LP6 Harness into the back of light, followed by the OEM harness, and set the entire light assembly inside your fairing. Do not fully tighten the adjustment hardware yet.

Step 5: Ensure the light is level. The ideal setting is 87.5 Degrees when the bike is level on the ground (not resting on its kickstand).

Step 6: Once the light is at the ideal angle, remove the DOT LP6 Assembly and tighten down the 4 bolts using a wrench. Then place the assembly back into the fairing.

Step 7: To reinstall the factory trim ring locate the spring on the inside top portion of the OEM light bezel trim ring. Insert the trim ring with the spring at about the 11 o'clock position. Rotate clockwise until the spring catches the hook circled in the image below. Next, insert the 6/32 Pillips pan head screw under the trim ring into the threaded hole. ***Do not overtighten the screw, this can cause the trim ring to warp/crush.***



Step 8: Tie up any loose cables and wires to ensure nothing is pinched or caught when reinstalling the OEM fairing.

^{*}Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.

^{*} Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
